



PORT-CALA BLANCA FAMILY ROUTE

The minimal difficulty and flat layout make it the ideal route to enjoy a pleasant family excursion beside the sea. This route extends throughout the entire **bahía de Xàbia**, from the port, the sheltered area of **Cap de Sant Antoni**, up to **Cala Blanca**, a set of three small coves. Throughout the route, we can watch the fishing boats and their fishing gear, the “**Tosqueres**”, sandstone quarries which date back to the Middle Ages which supplied stone to Xàbia for the construction of its buildings, as well as structures built in the Roman Period such as “**Els Banys de la Reina**” and “**Séquia de la Nòria**”. Thus, various trades, tradition and the scenery blend together into a route suitable for all ages.

Route Profile: Flat route at sea level.

DESCRIPTION:

We will follow the promenade: **Paseo del Puerto** up to the end of the jetty, returning along the same to take the bicycle lane along **Primer Muntanyar**, until we arrive at the beach: **Playa del Arenal**. We continue on **calle Atenas** avoiding the main road to arrive at **Cala Blanca**. Once there, we can visit the scenic viewpoint by climbing several stairways. On the return trip after the **Playa del Arenal**, we will take the Bicycle Lane which extends along the **Canal de la Fontana** which takes us along the **Av. Augusta** up to the route's starting point.
